From the time your parents considered all the possibilities and decided on their special choice for you, your name has been a part of the uniqueness that is especially "you." Names are significant enough to God that He often changed a name to better represent the changed person: Abram to *Abraham*, and Saul to *Paul*. The names of God given to us in His Word are not casually thought-out titles, but aids in helping us understand the all-encompassing aspects of His Personality.

In preparation for this musical selection, the choir has done a study on the names of God. A portion of that study is in your bulletin. You may wish to follow the names listed as they sing, and then during the week, use your bulletin in a devotional time. As the choir sings, think of the names of God that to you are the most meaningful . . . think of the names that represent those aspects of God's personality you need to learn more about. . . and then think of that particular name that God is going to use to help you right now.

NOTE TO THE ORGANIST

The organ part should be played as underscore to the spoken introduction. You will need to rehearse with the speaker so that you know exactly where to start playing. If all goes as planned, you should be on the third beat of the third measure as the spoken part is completed. The sole purpose of the musical introduction is to establish the correct pitch, and to this end, it should be done as smoothly and as unnoticed as possible. Use **soft stops**!
